REPORT ON EXPORT CERTIFICATES ISSUED BY THE NIGERIA EXPORT PROMOTION COUNCIL (NEPC) IN NASARAWA STATE

Period: 2018 - Till Date

Introduction:

The Nigerian Export Promotion Council (NEPC) is crucial in promoting non-oil exports in Nigeria. As part of its mandate, NEPC issues export certificates to firms that meet the required standards. This report provides an overview of the number of firms that have obtained export certificates from NEPC in Nasarawa State from 2018 till date.

Key Findings:

As of November 2024, 302 firms had obtained export certificates from NEPC in Nasarawa State. This indicates a growing interest in non-oil exports among firms in the state.

Conclusion:

- Firms in Nasarawa State should take advantage of the export opportunities available to them and work towards obtaining export certificates from NEPC.
